

Becoming a staff member at the Episcopal Youth Camp 2008



The Episcopal Youth Camp has a long tradition of quality adults serving the Diocesan youth by volunteering their time, talents and energy for one week in the summer. Please prayerfully consider continuing this tradition by offering to serve.



Positions: There are a variety of positions available for adult volunteers at summer camp. Perhaps you could serve as a week long cabin counselor, nurse or doctor? Maybe you have gifts & talents for music, outdoor adventure, formation, worship or leading games? We can also use people to come and work for a day as a registration nurse, or help in the office? If you are an ordained priest, we invite you to talk to someone about celebrating the Eucharist one day.

Responsibilities: The responsibilities vary based on your position - we have job descriptions for all the different positions. We do require that cabin counselors there for the entire week, including the 24 hours before for staff training. If you can't do that, we may still be able to use your gifts in a different position.



Requirements & training: All staff members must complete the pre-camp staff meeting and be certified in Safeguarding God's Children. Our medical directors are required to have all necessary & updated certifications and licenses.
